## ***BACHELOR OF ARTS IN INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES DEGREE PSYCHOLOGY CONCENTRATION***

### **UGA GRIFFIN CAMPUS ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Completion of at least 60 semester hours of transferable college credit by the application deadline
- Transfer GPA of at least 2.80 as calculated by the UGA Undergraduate Admissions Office (For Spring 2025 and afterward, the transfer GPA will be 3.00)
- Completion of high school at least one year prior to term of enrollment at UGA – Griffin
- Completion of at least one year of college by the term of intended enrollment

### **AB/IDS/PSYCHOLOGY DEGREE PROGRAM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:**

*The following courses **MUST** be completed to qualify for admission to the program:*

BIOL 1103-1103L or BIOL 1107-1107L or	Basic Concepts in Biology with lab or Principles of Biology I with lab or
PSYC 1101	Elementary Psychology
STAT 2000	Introductory Statistics

Students must have a 2.50 overall GPA across these three courses, with no grade below a C in any of them: PSYC 1101, STAT 2000, and a biology course with lab (BIOL 1103-1103L, BIOL 1104-1104L, BIOL 1107-1107L, or BIOL 1108-1108L).

Students are **strongly encouraged** to have completed a biology lab sequence (BIOL 1103-1103L and 1104-1104L, or BIOL 1107-1107L and 1108-1108L) before entering the AB/IDS/PSYC degree program.
